MoD OrderGuidelines for Procurement of MT/specialist vehicles

1. In supersession of all past orders on procurement of MT/specialist vehicles by Defence Services, instructions / guidelines contained in this MoD Order may be implemented with immediate effect.
2. **Approval-in-Principle** - Accordance of Approval-in-Principle (AIP) will be mandatory for each case related to procurement of vehicles, irrespective of its value. It will cover all types of Common user/Specialist vehicles. Service-specific vehicles like AFSVs, ASVs, etc will come under the category of Specialist vehicles. AIP will be accorded by following authorities for different kinds of cases of both Common user and Specialist vehicles as under -

3. Issues to be examined at the stage of according AIP in MoD -a. Necessity angle

- i. The vehicle should have been condemned against authorization and due for replacement as per existing norms.
- ii. The vehicle should be within the authorization.
- iii. Generally like to like replacement should be done. The change / re-authorization on account of revision of WE/PE in nomenclature from base model to upgraded model in respect of operational vehicles may be considered for according AIP by the

under whose powers the estimated value of case falls. There will be no requirement for giving separate AoN by concerned CFA/IFA and bidding process can be initiated straightaway in Open/Limited/PAC/Single bidding cases. In case of DGS&D procurements, approval for placing of Indent and Expenditure sanction may be given together by CFA/IFA once AIP has been accorded.

6. MoF approval for AIP will be required to Vehicle proposals under DPP route for cases falling under para 2 (a) and (b) above.
7. Supply of DGOF vehicles is not covered under these guidelines, as they do not fall within the ambit of 'Economy instructions', being in the nature of internal production from a dedicated in-house government facility.
8. These guidelines will also be applicable to vehicles being procured by Inter-service organizations and cases under MoD (Civil) budget.
9. These guidelines will be moderated by the extant Economy instructions, as and when issued by MoF. DPM provisions for vehicles' procurements stand amended as per these guidelines.
10. This is issued with the concurrence of FA (DS) and approval of Defence Secretary.
